Purpose: *To assess students' knowledge of information presented in the video.*

1. What animal name makes up the 5 reasons for possible extinction? **HIPPO**
2. If a habitat is disappearing, what would be happening to animals and plants living there?
THEY WOULD DIE TOO.
3. The official bird of the state of Hawaii is the **NENE GOOSE.**
4. The Big Island's Kapoho Bay tide pools were covered in lava in 2018. The black sand beach at Pohoiki Bay already has micro **PLASTIC** particles in the sand.
5. The horned insect destroying the coconut trees on all the islands is the **COCONUT RHINOSCEROS BEETLE**. It is considered a danger not only to the coconut trees but could also affect the papayas and other crops.
6. One African animal newly named to the Endangered list is the **GIRAFFE**. Numbers are down 40% in 30 years.
7. Name ONE endangered species living in Hawaii: **MONK SEAL; NENE GOOSE; HONU; ETC.**
8. We can help the environment by NOT using PLASTIC **BAGS** and **BOTTLES**. Carry your own to use.
9. What can you do to help clean up the beach? **PICK UP PLASTIC, LITTER, FISHING NETS.**

10. An increasing layer of air pollution traps in the earth's heat, causing **CLIMATE** changes.
